

BCS Fee Schedule 2020/21

Monthly fees

Parents may pay income based school fees if they provide a copy of their income tax statement form by June 1, before the school year starts. If parents decide against income-related school fees or do not submit their tax forms before the deadline, fees will be calculated based on the highest gross income in the fee schedule.

1.1. School fees

The gross annual income is the sum of all income of both parents/legal guardians from the last calendar year.

Families with an annual income of less than € 40,000 can request reduced school fees with proof of income in addition to individual evaluation.

* For further information regarding the school fees for a gross annual income of up to EUR 80,000, please contact our Finance department. There may be additional costs for the school concept and the additional academic program.

Reductions or instalment payments may be agreed with us upon request and after examination, provided that the economic circumstances justify this.

1.2. Parental contribution for All-Day care

* Parental contribution according to the guidelines of the Day care cost Co-Payment Act (TKBG), income based; **Grades 1 and 2 will get a voucher from 1.30 pm – 4.00 pm without a formal review.** Nonetheless an application must be submitted.

The All-Day care takes place for primary school starting at 7.30 am and after classes until 6 pm. Parents must complete a supplementary contract with BCS and have to submit an application for a "Hortgutschein" (afternoon care voucher) to the respective district office. The parental contribution is income based and determined by the authorities, in accordance with the Day Care Co-Payment Act (TKBG). The respective cost contribution is included in

the monthly invoice from BCS upon presentation of the voucher and is payable in addition to the BCS school fee.

1. 3. Meals (lunch, breakfast, drinks, snacks)
