

Admissions Policy

BCS welcomes students of families of all ethnic, cultural, professional and economic backgrounds as this diverse mix makes life at our school so special.

Though most students join BCS in September, we are happy to admit students throughout the year provided that we have places available. In admitting students to our school we are looking for a balance of boys and girls as well as a diverse mixture of national and cultural backgrounds.

An interview with parents is essential to the admission process to ensure that families and school have the same educational goals which lays the basis for a good collaboration between home and school. The decision to admit a prospective student to BCS will be made once the student has completed an agreed number of trial days. The Head of Admissions and the Principal will decide whether to admit a prospective student, taking into account teacher appraisals of the student.

BCS accepts all primary aged school students into its Primary Years Programme pending interview, student needs and the ability for BCS to meet those needs.

In order to be enrolled in the Diploma Programme students must have completed the intermediate secondary school certificate, the Mittlerer Schulabschluss (MSA), attained by the end of 10th grade. Students entering from outside of the German school system will have to show through their past academic records and a personal interview that they will be able meet the demands of the Diploma Programme.

Once a student has been admitted to BCS, he/she has a contractual trial period of 6 weeks. Final approval by the Principal and Vice Principal will be given only, if the student has shown good behaviour and a positive learning attitude at all times.
