

BCS School Clothing Policy

Grades 1-12

School clothing must be ordered from our official school clothing supplier "Dress for School" and secondary college jackets and sweaters can be purchased at BCS directly. School clothing is mandatory at all times from 7:30am to 6pm in the school building, in the courtyard, in parks and all excursions.

What is considered official school clothing?

All school clothing should be neat and clean. Clothing with holes and fringes is not acceptable.

Trousers, shorts, skirts and **leggings** must be plain navy in Primary School and plain navy, black or dark grey in Secondary School. Leggings must always be combined with skirts or shorts. Pants with holes and fringes are not acceptable. White or beige trousers, shorts, skirts may be worn in Summer.

Sports trousers/sweatpants must be navy or black and may only be worn during sports lessons.

Shoes should preferably be dark coloured and may only be worn in matching pairs. Flip-flops and alike are not allowed. All sandals must be closed at the heel for safety reasons.

Socks and tights may only be plain white, navy or black. Plain meaning no stripes, no flowers and alike.

Scarves, like tops, must be plain (no text, logos, patterns or designs) and in school colours only.

Make-up (including nail polish) is not allowed in Primary School. In Secondary School only decent make-up is allowed. **Tattoos** may not be visible at any time. **Hair** may be dyed in natural hair colours only.

Jewelry must be decent in Primary and Secondary School. **Piercings** may not be visible at any time with the exception of one piercing per ear. Loop earrings or alike may not be worn for safety reasons.

Caps must be BCS only and may be worn outside during the school day.

Sports clothes includes the official sports t-shirt for all sports lessons. In Secondary School, sports pants and shorts must be dark blue, dark grey or black. In Primary School, official sport pants and shorts are also mandatory. Sports clothes may not be worn at any other time of the day.

Tops (not including outdoor jackets) must have the official BCS logo on it. Hoodies connected to BCS may be worn --this includes club hoodies (i.e. MUN and BCS sports teams or specially approved of BCS hoodies). A student should bring at least two layers of tops to school (e.g. t-shirt plus sweatshirt) in case the temperatures change. **Non BCS Outdoor jackets are not allowed to be worn in school.** Students must ensure they bring enough layers, this may include turtlenecks worn under school clothing, or an extra sweater for comfort.

How much school clothing should a student have?

All students must have enough school clothing to be dressed properly for a whole school week. This means, they should **at least** have:

- 5 BCS shirts
- 1 BCS sweatshirt/ hoody/ sweater
- 2-3 trousers or skirts
- 1 BCS sports-shirt (mandatory)
- 1 BCS sports-shorts or sweatpants

Can we alter the school clothing?

School clothing may **not be altered** in any way. The only exception being, altering the lengths of trousers, skirts or dresses.

May anyone stitch the BCS Logo on clothing?

The BCS logo is a registered brand and any usage or reproduction without prior formal consent by the school management is illegal.

Student Responsibilities

- Ensure their clothing is in line with the clothing policy.
- Have a back-up set of clothing in their locker.
- Ask Teachers or Principals if there are any questions or concerns about the policy.

Teacher Responsibilities

- Ensure at the beginning of each lesson that every student is abiding by the above policy.
- Ask any student not adhering to the BCS clothing policy to change into their back-up set of school clothing located in the respective student's locker. If student is does not have back-up clothing and cannot borrow any they may be sent home to get needed school clothing.
- Ensure that there is a visible updated BCS clothing policy in their classrooms.
